

Application for Determination of Status as an Employee or a Self-Employed Person

This form is for use by persons who wish to obtain a decision for determination of status as an employee or a self-employed person, under either section 44 of the *Act respecting parental insurance* or section 65 of the *Act respecting the Québec Pension Plan*. A decision under either of these acts is valid for both of them and determines whether, for the year covered, contributions must be made on an employer and employee basis **or** on a self-employed basis.

You may complete this form as the **principal** or the **worker**. The terms **principal** and **worker** mean respectively the employer and employee, if such is their status. The *Act respecting the Québec Pension Plan* and the *Act respecting parental insurance* provide that the worker be notified of an application made by the principal and that the principal be notified of an application made by the worker. An application for determination of status will be accepted only in cases of disagreement between the principal and the worker concerning the worker's status.

An application made by the principal may cover a number of workers in the same employment category, that is, doing the same kind of work under the same conditions.

In this case, attach a list of the workers concerned and provide the name, address, social insurance number and telephone number of each worker.

If the workers are not in the same employment category, complete a separate application for each category.

If Revenu Québec previously notified the parties in writing of its decision regarding determination of status as an employee or self-employed person under the *Act respecting parental insurance* or the *Act respecting the Québec Pension Plan*, you must enclose with this application a copy of the letter and indicate the reasons a new decision is being requested.

Complete form RR-65.A-V, *Questionnaire for Determination of Status as an Employee or a Self-Employed Person*, and enclose it with this application.

Applications must be sent, by registered mail, on or before April 30 of the year following the year covered by the application. Please address applications to Revenu Québec, 3800, rue de Marly, Québec (Québec) G1X 4A5.
