

If you were **born before January 1, 1957**, and you had a spouse (see note below), you and your spouse can **jointly decide** to include a portion of your retirement income in the calculation of your spouse's income. For more information, see "Transfer of retirement income between spouses" in the instructions for line 122 in the guide.

If you transfer a portion of your retirement income to your spouse, you must also transfer the corresponding Québec income tax withheld from that income.

Only the person transferring retirement income must enclose Schedule Q with their return.
