

Election by Fishers to Have Income Tax Deducted at Source

Complete this form if you are a self-employed fisher and you elect to have income tax deducted at source from all income you derive from fishing.

To make this election, you must complete this form and submit it to the buyer of fishery products, the buyer's agent, or any other person designated or considered to be your employer. If the election involves more than one employer, you must submit a separate form, duly completed, to each employer. Your employer will deduct an amount equal to 15% income tax from the remuneration paid.

This election takes effect on the date you make it and remains in force until you decide to revoke it. In this case, you must complete a new copy of this form and submit it to your employer(s).
