Income Tax Assistance – Volunteer Program

The income tax assistance program is the result of a major partnership established in 1988 between the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) and Revenu Québec. It provides assistance to people who are unable to complete their tax returns and cannot afford the services of tax professionals. Every year, organizations and volunteers assist a large number of people by completing their income tax returns for free.

Help promote equality in your community by enabling people to receive the benefits and tax credits they are entitled to!

Become a participating organization and hold income tax return preparation sessions.

As a participating organization, you:

- will be guided and supported by CRA and Revenu Québec coordinators throughout the year;
- could be eligible for two grants, one offered by the CRA and one offered by Revenu Québec, under the income tax assistance program;
- can take advantage of a computer donation program run by the CRA, through which you could receive free laptop computers if you are eligible (depending on equipment availability);
- will have access to an online toolkit to help you recruit volunteers and promote the program; and
- will receive certificates of appreciation from the CRA and Revenu Québec.

Your volunteers will:

- get basic how-to training on completing personal income tax returns;
- have free access to income tax return preparation software;
- have access to dedicated toll-free phone lines where they can get answers to their tax-related questions during return preparation sessions; and
- receive certificates of appreciation issued by the CRA and Revenu Québec.

Once you have completed the online registration form, an assistance program coordinator will contact you. Don't miss out on this great opportunity to help the members of your community, whose gratitude will warm your hearts!
